Project Objectives:

The project's overall objective is to promote active youth participation in their communities and to build youth workers' and youth leaders' capacity to maximize youths potential for social innovation in tackling the problems of youth unemployment and for promoting social inclusion, social innovation, gender empowerment and sustainable human development in participating communities.

Activities:

WP1: Capacity Building Activities

Building youth multipliers' and youth workers' capacity for tackling youth unemployment and promoting sustainable development in local communities:

1. 6 day capacity-building seminar "Fighting Youth Unemployment with Social Innovation projects" for youth multipliers and youth workers
 - To be held: 21st till 27th February in Hanoi, Vietnam
 - 3 participants from Croatia, France, Greece and Peru, 5 participants from Indonesia, Japan, Thailand and 15 participants from Vietnam = 42 total
2. Youth Leaders Manual "Social Innovation Competences – Becoming a Game Changer in Your Communities".
 - To be produced: March–May 2016
